**Notice to Delta/Northwest Customers**

*Operations Consolidate at Little Rock National Airport March 10*

**Little Rock, Arkansas (March 5, 2009)** -Delta Air Lines is consolidating operations at Little Rock National Airport. All Northwest operations at LIT will move to the Delta facilities beginning the morning of March 10th.

All Northwest customers arriving at Little Rock National Airport are advised to check-in at the Delta ticket counter. For the convenience of passengers, all Northwest and Delta flights will depart out of gates 2, 4 or 6.

"Delta is committed to achieving a seamless integration, and we will keep customers informed if there are operational changes at their airports and will continue to deploy additional kiosks and staff to provide direction and assistance for customers when there are location changes as well as sharing updates with our customers via email, delta.com, nwa.com and with additional airport signage as needed", says Delta Air Lines Station Manager, Michael Raine.

The new airline, called Delta and headquartered in Atlanta, began its first day as a combined company in October. The merger brings several benefits to customers that will be rolled out over the next 24 months which include:

- Creation of additional connecting opportunities
- Complimentary upgrades for elite members of both airlines' loyalty programs
- Consolidation of the Delta/Northwest loyalty programs
- Launch of a fully consolidated worldwide flight schedule in advance of summer 2009
