*American Eagle Adds More Capacity at Little Rock National Airport*

**Little Rock, Arkansas (April 7, 2009)** – American Eagle has replaced three 50-seat aircrafts from LIT to DFW with four 64-seat ATR 72 turbo prop aircraft. The changes will add 106 daily seats to the LIT-DFW market.

"I do not anticipate that schedules and flight times will change. The performance of the ATR 72 is very similar to the 50 seat jets on short flights", says Airport Executive Director, Ron Mathieu.
